## 2017 Information Sheet Concerning Regulations for the AP Exams

AP Exams will be administered May 1st- 12th, 2017

Check your AP Bulletin for specific AP Exam dates.

### **Students will be responsible for bringing:**

1. Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for all multiple-choice answer sheets.
2. Black or dark-blue ballpoint pens for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.
3. School code, ECHS is 112723.
4. A watch (in case the exam room does not have a clock that can be easily seen-*no* cell phones)
5. **A photo ID** (Driver's license, Infinite campus printout with picture), students will not be admitted to the test session without a valid photo ID.
6. A calculator with the necessary capabilities if you are taking an AP Calculus, Statistics, Physics, Biology or Chemistry exam. Please see the College Board's student site or consult your teacher for a list of approved calculators. Each student may bring up to two calculators, from the approved list.

### **Do Not Bring:**

1. Books or book bags, compasses, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes. Make arrangements to leave book bags in your car or locker.
2. Rulers and straightedges. (except for AP Physics test)
3. Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets).
4. Computers or calculators except as noted above.
5. Watches that beep or have an alarm. Turn alarms off on calculators.
6. Portable listening or recording devices-even with headphones-or photographic equipment.
7. Cellular phones, or personal digital assistants (PDA's).
8. Clothing with subject-related information.
9. Food or drinks will not be allowed in the testing room. You may bring items for the break and leave them outside the room. Put your name on these items.

**\*\*School Rules and Dress Codes will be enforced.**

**\*\*The Testing Room will be "Closed" when the directions begin. Students *will not* be admitted late.**
