East Coweta High School is a comprehensive, four-year public high school serving students in grades 9-12 and located in the rural/suburban community of Sharpsburg, GA. One of 3 high schools in the economically diverse **Coweta County School District**, it is located 30 miles south of Atlanta in one of the state's fastest growing areas. Enrollment is approximately **3048** with a student population of 58.2% White; 23.3% African American; 10.6% Hispanic; 3.3% Asian; and 4.5% other.

East Coweta is accredited by the *Southern Association of Colleges and Schools*.

Curriculum

The Academic program is organized on a **4X4 Block Schedule**. Students take a maximum of four (4) courses/ credits per semester and attend four, 95- minute block classes per day. A total of 8 credits are attempted each academic year. Block scheduling was first implemented in the 1998-99 school year.

Number of AP classes: 17 – *American Lit, 12th Grade English, Calculus, Statistics, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Science, Biology, French, Spanish, European History, U.S. History, Microeconomics, Government, Human Geography, Psychology, Computer Science*

Advanced level (Honors) courses are offered in *Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy & Physiology, Zoology, Civics, World History, US History, Economics, 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grade English, and Level III of Spanish, French, and German*. The **Math Curriculum** is offered on a regular and accelerated track.

AP and Honors courses are weighted in the cumulative GPA, not individual courses. AP and DE (Dual Enrollment) academic courses receive 10 quality points averaged into the student's Weighted GPA. Advanced, Gifted, STEM, and Accelerated courses receive 5 quality points averaged into the student's Weighted GPA.
