For students who did not receive an email, students can access scores electronically by setting up a free College Board account. Students can set up a free College Board account at any time and will use this throughout high school and the college application and admission testing process. After creating an account, if a student doesn't see their scores when they log in, or they are told there is no record of them taking the test once they log in, they will need to enter an access code. ## Attendance News:

- **Attendance Check-Outs** - In accordance with the other schools in Coweta, we do not accept emails for phone calls for check-outs. There will be a plan in place for emergencies, but this is a county wide policy. If you will be leaving school early without a parent coming into the school to check you out, please **bring a written note that morning to Attendance**. This note should include the time you are leaving campus, the reason why (ie. Dr. appointment, trip, etc) and a valid phone number. **All notes will be verified.**
- **Certificate of School Enrollment and ADAP (Alcohol and Drug Awareness) Certificate** - signed up for your forms **24 hours in advance**. These forms are needed BEFORE going to the DMV.
