You must register with the Selective Service System... Do a favor for yourself and your country. It's the law. You can register:

1.) through the Selective Service internet website at www.sss.gov; 2.) by completing a form at the post office; or 3.) by meeting with the Registrar at ECHS. By registering, not only will you be ensuring that a future draft is

fair, you'll also be staying eligible for federal student financial aid, job training benefits, and most federal employment.

Attendance News:

- **Attendance Check-Outs - No emails or call accepted for early check-out.**
Reminder: In accordance with the other schools in Coweta, we no longer accept emails for check-outs. There will be a plan in place for emergencies, but this is a county wide policy. If a student is leaving school early without a parent coming into the school to check you out, they must bring a written note that morning to Attendance. This note should include the time you are leaving campus, the reason why (ie. Dr. appointment, trip, etc) and a valid phone number. All notes will be verified before the student can leave the school.
- **Certificate of School Enrollment and ADAP (Alcohol and Drug Awareness) Certificate - signed up for your forms 24 hours in advance.** These forms are needed **BEFORE** going to the DMV.
