### **A child needs you as a friend!**

Elm Street Elementary School is looking for adults who are interested in mentoring a student. Mentors generally meet once a week with their mentee and have lunch with their student or work on academics. Spending time with a child one-on-one can make a huge difference in his/her life. For example, you can read them a book, have them read to you, help with math, have lunch with them, or just be there to listen. A mentor is asked to visit a child 30 minutes per week in the school setting. We ask mentors to make a commitment for a minimum of one school year.

There are several trainings offered at CEC in Newnan; however, you only have to attend one training session. Mentor sessions at CEC are **September 23, October 20, November 4, and December 9**. After you complete training, mentors must have their fingerprints taken and have a criminal background check. Once that is finished, mentors will be matched with a student!
