

House Bill 251 (2009)
Public School Choice
Coweta County
School District-Parent Annual Choice Notification Letter

As the parent or guardian of a student in a Georgia School System, currently enrolled in our school district, we are writing to notify you that under a new state law you may be allowed to request to transfer your child to another public school in the same school district.

Under this law, a parent or guardian, can request to have his or her child transferred to another public school within the assigned school district of residence as long as the school district has determined that there is available classroom space at the school after all assigned students have been enrolled, and as long as the school system is not under any court approved desegregation orders that would not allow the transfer. The Coweta County School System **is** currently under a desegregation order and will not be allowed to implement transfers under this new state law at this time. Once the Coweta County School System has been released from the desegregation order by the Justice Department, we will post guidelines for these transfers on this website.
