Dear Parents of LMS Students:

For the second year in a row, teachers at Lee Middle School have collaborated to create one standardized supply list for all grade-levels and one standardized way of maintaining binders. Keeping work organized is a challenge, and we believe that learning one system to use throughout their middle school career will help students establish a system that works.

In order to make things even easier, sixth grade teachers will sell binders already set up and stocked with the requisite supplies. These binders will cost \$45.00 and will be handed out to students during orientation or on the first day of school. These binders are an upgrade from last year's model. They are name-brand, heavy duty, 2" binders. Take the worry out of searching for the school supply lists, the back-to-school pandemonium, arguing about which binder to buy (the red, the blue, the one with the pockets, the one with the zippers...), or worrying about what to bring on the first day! We will deliver binders to your child on his or her first day of school or at orientation the week before school starts.

Additionally, we will prepare a teacher gift package also available for purchase. This bundle will include items that students use throughout the year in the classroom – 2 boxes of tissue, one roll of paper towels, one 15 oz. hand sanitizer, and one container of disinfecting wipes (Clorox or Lysol). This is available for \$15 and will be delivered with the binders.

To order one or both of the bundles, please complete the form below and mail it to LMS labeled BINDER ORDER at the address above while supplies last. If you do not opt to purchase a pre-made binder, supply lists will be available at local stores this summer and on the Lee Middle School website.

This is a fundraiser, and 100% of the money raised goes toward classroom technology. However, the cost of the binder is not inflated. The school saves money by purchasing in bulk; and in turn we sell the binder at or below retail prices. The difference is the money we use to purchase CPS units (clickers!), writing slates, projectors, etc. It's a win-win scenario, so we encourage you to take advantage of the offer. We truly appreciate your help with this opportunity to raise money for our classes.
