The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 requires parents/guardians who have children attending a Title I school to be notified of how well their school is preparing students for college and/or a career, as well as the school's designation under Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver.

Under the 2015 renewal of Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver, certain Title I schools continue to be designated as Reward, Priority, or Focus Schools. The Waiver allows the use of the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) as the comprehensive report card for all schools in Georgia, providing a score between 0-100 for each school - measuring how well the school is doing in preparing students to be successful in college and/or a career.

I am very proud to tell you that Newnan High has not been given a school designation this year, meaning we are a Title I school continuing to provide quality education to all of our students.
