2009-2010 SUPPLY LIST**

KINDERGARTEN

One pack 8 count Crayola crayons
One pack 24 count Crayola crayons
One 8-10 ct. of non-permanent basic colors broad point markers
One box of Kleenex or Puffs tissues
Four Elmer's glue sticks (.21 oz size)
One roll of paper towels
One large pink block eraser
Two bottles of Softsoap hand soap
One box of baby wipes or Lysol wipes
One purple portfolio folder for art (not plastic)
One book bag - not rolling. Storage is an issue and your child will only have papers to bring home.

FIRST GRADE

Two packs 16 count Crayola crayons
One pair sharp Fiskar scissors (children's size)
Two boxes of tissues
One roll paper towels
One pencil box (no pouches, please)
One dozen of sharpened #2 pencils
One green pocket folder for Art Class (not plastic)
One container of Clorox or Lysol wipes (boys)
One pack of 4 expo Fat dry erase markers low odor (girls)
Two glue sticks

Individual teachers may request additional supplies. Please check with your child's teacher. Please do not send rolling book bags as we do not have adequate storage for them

SECOND GRADE

One box facial tissues
One 8 oz. Bottle Elmer's Glue
One pack 24 count Crayola crayons
One pair Fiskar scissors (Children's size)
One pencil box
One dozen #2 pencils

* The Art Teacher is also requesting an **orange 2 pocket folder with prongs** to be used in Art Class (not plastic)

Boys

One roll of paper towels
One box of snack or pint sized baggies

Girls

One bottle of anti-bacterial hand sanitizer
One box of sandwich or quart sized baggies

One book bag - not rolling. Storage is an issue and your child will only have their reading book and agenda to bring home.

THIRD GRADE

White, 3 ring, 1 1/2" binder with clear plastic pocket front
Pencil pouch (for binder)
Crayons/markers
Pencils
Notebook paper (wide rule)
Two yellow pocket folders for Art & Music Classes (not plastic)
Glue stick or bottled glue
Student scissors
1 pack of dry erase markers
3 boxes of tissues
2 rolls of paper towels

*All 3rd grade students will use a white, 1 1/2 inch, 3-ring notebook containing their agenda at the beginning of the year. This will go home every day and will contain everything they need for their classes. Due to daily wear-and-tear, the notebook may need to be replaced by the student sometime during the year.

Optional items: wet wipes, band-aids, Air fresheners or Anti-bacterial sprays, 409 cleaner, baggies (sandwich, quart, gallon)

*Individual teachers may request additional supplies.

FOURTH GRADE

One pair of scissors
One set of colored pencils or 16-pack crayons
#2 pencils - no mechanical - **wooden only**
Two packs of Dry erase markers (4 pack)
Glue stick (stick or liquid)
Bar eraser
Pencil pouch - preferably 3 hole punch for binder
Two boxes of kleenex
Two red ink pens
Two black and white composition books
Six dividers with pockets
Two 3-ring binder notebooks - no larger than 2"
Notebook paper - wide rule
Hand sanitizer
Plastic protractor
Two blue pocket folders for Art & Music Classes (not plastic)

FIFTH GRADE

2 pencils - no mechanical - **wooden only**
Two red ink pens
One 16-pack Crayola Crayons
Bar eraser
Glue - liquid
Wide rule notebook paper - to last throughout the year
3-ring binder - no larger than 2"
Graph paper - 1 cm grid
One box Kleenex
Pencil pouch - preferably 3 hole punch for binder
Two red pocket folders for Art & Music Classes (not plastic)
